## **New Features and Enhancements**

**TAD Region Scrolling:** The TAD (Terrorist Acts Database) now allows users to scroll through all geographical regions in order to more easily analyze terrorist events around the world.

**Better Assessment Workflow:** Site Profiler 1.2 Assessor now includes a better workflow and report structure that makes the user's job of analyzing and commenting on assessment findings easier. The workflow utilizes a more refined, cleaner interface for identifying and collecting assessment findings or observations.

**Risk Icons:** Site Profiler 1.2 Assessor includes left-side risk icons integrated with IDR / ODO checkboxes. When editing IDR's, users have access to the checkboxes for associating with assets, threats, and mitigation function. At all other times, the Planner-style risk icons provide the user with an up-to-the-minute summary of their assets, threats, and mitigation functions.

**Stability & Performance Enhancements:** Site Profiler 1.2 is more stable and performs better than ever before. Numerous stability and performance improvements combine to amplify the speed and reliability with which your clients can complete their analyses.

- Stability of closing and re-opening files addressed
- Issues involving the selection, moving, and hiding of Model Executions fixed
- 3D text labels are no longer cut-off after re-opening a file
- Maps can no longer accidentally be scaled to 0
- Screen is properly cleared after closing a file
- Interview/3D toggle button on short-form no longer gets confused
- The height of the short-form now persists between screens
- Mitigation function icons are now drawn properly
- Special characters (&, %, etc.) now appear properly in risk and review tables
- Background colors have been completely updated to new format
- RIN update freezing when short-form is maximized has been fixed
- The system alerts users when they try to create files with existing names
- The system no longer has problems when SQL server is stopped at startup
- Model thumbnails now appear correctly for all models
- Several 3D model problems (jersey barriers, trees, shrubs, businessman, trailer office) have been corrected
- Initial cost data on vehicles has been formatted correctly
- Refresh button on Mitigation Function Summary no longer performs a 'New'
